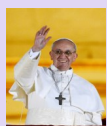

Thank you for giving up your time so freely and regularly to serve our school.

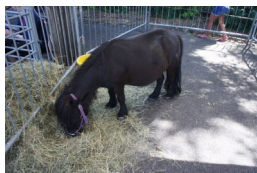

To all our sponsors, who donated prizes for the fair, thank you to so many local businesses and sports organisations.

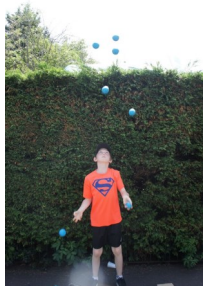
We hope that the children had an exceptional time and that they will remember the Summer Fair for a very long time.
