Medical ALERT

You may have heard in the news of two illnesses that may cause your child to become really unwell.

Strep Throat Signs that suggest your child might have Strep throat are:

Fever within the last 24 hours / White spots at the back of their throat (pus on their tonsils) /Very large or red tonsils / Sore (tender) lumps under their chin. If you are concerned that your child might have these symptoms please contact 111, your GP Surgery, or Walk-in Centre for advice.

<u>Scarlet Fever</u> Symptoms include a sore throat, headache, and fever, along with a fine, pinkish or red body rash with a tiny, rough pimples ("sandpapery" feel). On darker skin the rash can be more difficult to see but again the skin will have a sandpapery feel. They might have a very red tongue or lips.

Contact NHS 111 or your GP if you are worried.

Please talk to your children/ and check their bags for any holiday work/ letters they were given and ensure it is completed for their return in January. If no work was given, then please encourage your child to read their reading book from school or a library book. Ask them to read to you or any members of the family.
